Important Reminder: Blacktown Parking

Our parishioners **must not** use the upper carpark directly opposite the hall, but should use in the lower carpark at the bottom of the driveway or park on the street. This applies to *everyone*, including those arriving late to Mass.

Explanation of Collections and Accounts

In Australia, parishes take up two Sunday collections: the first collection is for all clergy expenses such as presbytery, food, priests' stipend, medical & vehicle expenses; the second collection covers those expenses related to the church and liturgy, such as rental for the chapel/churches we use, vestments, candles, insurance, utilities, etc.

Our apostolate also has a third ("reserve") account for the Building Fund. Building Fund donations are not used for day-to-day expenses, because they are reserved exclusively for our future needs.

The bank details on the back page of the bulletin can be used to set up automatic contributions to the various accounts via your own net-banking facility (e.g. weekly, fortnightly or monthly contributions). *However these account numbers cannot be used to make a deposit in-person at a bank branch.*

Our accounts are held in the Diocesan Development Fund but they are completely independent/separate accounts and belong entirely to the FSSP.

Since we are not a canonical parish, we do not pay any diocesan "tax" out of our collections. (Parishes give 15% of their *first collection* to the diocese.)

Unfortunately in Australia, it is not possible to claim a tax deduction for your personal contributions toward church collections, however *business sponsorship can be used as a tax deduction.*
